

## Food regulatory declaration of conformity

## Product using and application:

Products referenced above declaration, under normal and foreseeable conditions of use, which do not cause any unacceptable change in the composition or a deterioration in the organoleptic characteristics of the food product, are suitable for direct food packaging, excluding alcohol containing products and liquid milk products.

## Limitations of use:

Products referenced above declaration are not designed for usage in high temperatures including: cooking (in temp. above 100°C), sterilization, heating in oven or microwave oven (in temp. above 100°C), direct consumption or for usage by children.

## Temperatures relevant for certified films:

Welding temperature: 150-200°CExploitation temperature: 15-30°C

Storage temperature: 15-25°C, humidity below 75%Rh.

This declaration of conformity is only valid for the specific mentioned use. It is only valid as long as no changes in composition, used raw materials or the production-process, as well as the relevant legal provisions, are made.
